This Act may be cited as the Prevention of Terrorism (Denial of Bail) Act.

For the purposes of section 5 (3A) (b) of the Constitution, the offences related to terrorism in respect of which an arrested or detained person shall not be admitted to bail under section 5 (3A) (a) of the Constitution shall be the offences under sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 12 and 15 of the Prevention of Terrorism Act.
