Rules made by the Judges of the Supreme Court under section 198 of the Courts Act

- 1. These rules may be cited as the Letters of Request Rules 1985.
- 2. (1) Where, in relation to any civil, commercial or criminal matter which is pending before a Court or tribunal of another State, provision is made in an enactment or a Convention to which Mauritius is party, or it appears desirable—
 - (a) to obtain the testimony of a witness in Mauritius; or
 - (b) to serve any process on a person in Mauritius,

a Judge may, on an ex parte application by the Attorney-General or a person duly authorised to make the application on behalf of that foreign Court or tribunal, and on production of the Letter of Request and such other evidence as the Judge may require, including a further copy of any process to be served, make an order in compliance with the Letter of Request.

- (2) An order under paragraph (1) shall be in the form A or B set out in the First Schedule.
- (3) The examination of a witness and the service of process shall, subject to any enactment, be made in accordance with the procedure laid down in the Convention or with such directions as may be specified in the Letter of Request.
- 3. (1) Where the examination of a witness has been conducted by a person other than the Registrar or where service of process has been effected, the deposition or the return of service shall be forwarded to the Registrar.
 - (2) The Registrar shall—
 - (a) cause the seal of the Supreme Court to be affixed to the deposit or return;

- (b) sign a certificate in the form A or B set out in the Second Schedule;
- (c) forward the certificate and the annexures referred to therein to the Attorney-General, for transmission to the foreign Court or tribunal
- 4. The following enactments are revoked—
 - (a) Additional Rules relating to Commissions Rogatoires and Letters of Request 1911 Lane II/253;
 - (b) Letters of Request Rules 1922 Lane II/257.
