SWORN WEIGHERS ACT

EDITORIAL NOTE: The words "Comptroller of Customs" have been deleted and replaced by the words "Director-General", following the passing of Act 33 of 2004.

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Sworn Weighers Act.

2. Interpretation

In this Act-

"Director-General" means the Director-General of the Mauritius Revenue Authority;

"goods" means goods on which customs duties according to weight are leviable, whether on importation or exportation;

"Minister" means the Minister to whom responsibility for the subject of commerce is assigned.

3. Appointment of sworn weighers

- (1) The Minister may, on the recommendation of the Director-General, appoint such fit and proper persons to be sworn weighers as he thinks fit.
- (2) Every person so appointed shall take an oath in the form specified in the Schedule before the Master and Registrar, after which the Minister shall issue a commission to that person.
 - (3) No person shall act as sworn weigher unless he holds a commission.
