TIME ACT

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Time Act.

2. Interpretation

In this Act—

“Minister” means the Minister to whom responsibility for the subject of energy is assigned;

“period of summertime” means—

- (a) the period specified in regulations made under section 4 (b); or
- (b) where no period has been specified in regulations made under section 4 (b), the period—
 - (i) beginning at 2 o'clock standard time in the morning of the last Sunday of October in any year; and
 - (ii) ending at 2 o'clock standard time in the morning of the last Sunday of March in the following year;

“standard time” has the same meaning as in the Interpretation and General Clauses Act;

“summertime” means—

- (a) the time specified in regulations made under section 4 (a); or
- (b) where no time has been specified in regulations made under section 4 (a), one hour ahead of the standard time.

3. Time applicable in Mauritius

(1) Subject to subsection (2), the time applicable in Mauritius shall be the standard time.

(2) During the period of summertime, the time applicable in Mauritius shall be the summertime.

4. Regulations

The Minister may, by regulations, specify—

- (a) the summertime; and
- (b) the period of summertime.
