A BILL

To provide for the issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sums necessary to meet the expenditure, both recurrent and capital, in respect of the services of Government for the financial year 2021-2022 and for the appropriation of those sums by votes of expenditure

ENACTED by the Parliament of Mauritius, as follows -

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the Appropriation (2021-2022) Act 2021.

2. Appropriation of sums for services of Government

(1) A total sum not exceeding one hundred forty-five billion and seven hundred million rupees (Rs.145,700,000,000) shall be issued from the Consolidated Fund to meet the expenditure, both recurrent and capital, in respect of the services of Government for the financial year 2021-2022.

(2) The expenditure of the total sum under subsection (1) shall be appropriated by votes of expenditure, in conformity with the Schedule and the Estimates 2021-2022 laid before the Assembly.
